

When battling with motivation – look back, look forward and look to the wise.

This is a place I do not want to be. The excitement of the big race is over. The medal is hanging on the wall and I don't feel the same about my running as I did. It's all over, now someone has to clean up after the party and I have a hangover.

Worse, I am now more of a man since finishing the race, about 3 kilogrammes more. I wonder how many people, runners, ordinary folk there are that are struggling with their motivation to run. But to make matters even worse, it is winter, it's dark outside and its cold. What is strange is that it never seemed to bother me before. Now my interest in the weather and the early morning temperatures in particular seems all-consuming.

This clearly is a time to take stock, a time for reflection. For indeed if I don't want to run, at least I can reflect. I would often run to the top a hill while training and stop at the top and look back. This is a good exercise to do, for it is only once you are at the top, you can get an appreciation of what you have done. You get perspective of the hill, your ability and given some of the hills, just how darn tough you really are.

And so I look back now and think that my running has been a really good thing for me. I have come a long way and well, I am a bit fitter than my contemporaries. Notwithstanding the post Marathon blues, on reflection the years I have spent running have been good; have been fun and definitely worthwhile.

So I look forward and ponder my running future, Marathon? Again? I'm not ready to ponder that much, I have a job of work to do and a family to attend to. So I will ponder just to the end of the month and take it from there. I know if I can just get back into the habit of getting up early and running out the kitchen door for a week all will be well. This is not the mighty runner and conqueror of hills last seen on Marathon day, true, but it is where I am and this is how I'll deal with it. Baby steps, just baby steps.

And where do I draw my inspiration? I turn to Brutus Hamilton. For he had this to say about distance running: "It is one of the strange ironies of this strange life that those who work the hardest, who subject themselves to the strictest discipline, who give up certain pleasurable things in order to achieve a goal are the happiest men.

When you see 20 or 30 (thousand) line up for a distance race in some meet, don't pity them, don't feel sorry for them. Better envy them instead".

So where to from here? Tomorrow morning I run out the kitchen door at 05h30, care to join me?

WMA-GENERAL ASSEMBLY-PUERTO RICO-JULY 2003 COMPETITION DECISIONS:

Report by Wilma Perkins

The following is a summary of technical decisions taken at the General Assembly of World Masters Athletics held in Puerto Rico in July 2003. It is pleasing to report that a number of these decisions were as a result of notices of motion that were put forward by Australia.

- That the age for International competition will be 35 years for both men and women (awaiting formal approval from the IAAF)
- That WMA Indoor World Championships have now been sanctioned (the first will be held in March 2004 at Sindelfingen, Germany)
- The WMA Non-Stadia program has had the 50 km run replaced by a 10 km run
- For teams scoring in WMA road races, cross country and road walking every athlete competes individually in his/her own age group. For teams scoring athletes will only be permitted to drop to a lower age group to complete the required number for a team provided that the following requirements are met:
- 1. The lower age group shall be in the same race as that as the athlete competes individually
- 2. The athlete's country does not have a sufficient number of athletes competing in that age group to make up a team
- 3. Every team must submit a start list that shows the name and age group making up a team
- 4.An athlete may only score in one team
- 5. Athletes may only be moved down not up in age groups
- Entries to all WMA World Championships may be submitted through their National
 affiliate in either hard copy form or electronically. Entries submitted direct by
 athletes will only be validated upon approval from their national affiliate.
- Rule changes approved by the IAAF require WMA endorsement before introduction into Masters competition
- Hurdle Rule amendment: Competitors must hurdle with a continuous motion thus ensuring that both feet bust be off the ground for at least an instant
- Only one competition number shall be required in throwing events
- · WMA has not adopted the current IAAF one false start rule
- WMA has introduced the WEIGHT THROW as an individual event at future World competitions
- · WMA is to reconsider events that make up the outdoor pentathlon.


