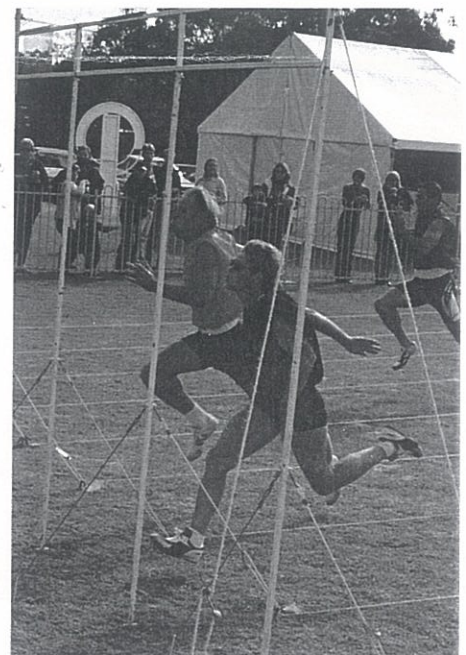

LEADING UP TO THE 21ST
PERTH MARATHON ON 4
JULY 1999

Last year I told the tale (published in the Community Newspaper /Cockburn Gazette on Friday 3 July 1998) behind my "running career" following the death of my son, Ricky, in March 1996. In utilising the healing powers of running, through my grief I have covered many kilometres on the roads of Perth and elsewhere. I will be running this Marathon (my 3rd) as a tribute to Ricky and two of his brave young friends, Matthew and Justin. In 1996 these 3 young boys joined the dozen or so unsuspecting West Australian children who lose their battle with brain cancer each year. Their battle was full of trauma, but embodied the "marathon" conviction and hope of children faced with adversity through illness.

The misfortune of these young boys was the catalyst for the 3 Boys Legacy (3BL). The 3 sets of parents and our significant others, urged by our sons' courage and strength, have banded together vowing to do whatever possible to prevent other families having to go through the same ordeal. This has resulted in a plan to establish the world's best children's brain cancer research facility here in Western Australia, modelled on a similar venture established by leukaemia sufferers 12 years ago which has significantly increased survival rates for the disease.

3BL has received tremendous support from the Variety Club, which has sponsored the salary of a world class research fellow commencing work at Princess Margaret Hospital for Children in July this year. There is still a lot of money to be raised to support the research and I am dedicating my Marathon effort in a hope to raise the profile of 3BL and hopefully achieve some additional sponsors for the research into children's brain cancer.
