

The Editor,

During 1999 Athletica (which took over from AAWA) conducted a Cross Country and Road Racing competition for clubs licensed by Athletica. Our club does not have a license, as I understand the position, but is permitted to compete under our own name and club uniform.

The competition has all sorts of rules and a Champion Club trophy is awarded on a points system. As one of the Vets who has regularly competed and supported this competition I am disappointed that Athletica has not, to my knowledge, provided a written report to our Club as to the outcome of the winter competition. With two events to go the Vets, surprisingly, were neck and neck with the Mandurah club for the trophy- I still don't know the outcome and final placings or points scored.

The State Half Marathon Championship, which was conducted by the Marathon club this year on behalf of Athletica was a success except that the points scored by our Club members were apparently not counted. I fully recognise that we all run and compete for our own pleasure but if Athletica want Clubs to support such a programme they must provide regular feedback to Clubs and competitors.

My personal view, based on recent years experience, is that Athletica should consider canceling the whole winter 2000 programme and leave it to the Marathon Club which puts together an 'open' event almost every weekend. I will be away at the AGN in April but would like all members to consider instructing our delegate to Athletica to bring the suggestion to the notice of the Board of Athletica and its winter committee.

I would also like to suggest that the State Half Marathon be used as our Club half marathon. Bob Sammells has indicated that he would rather run the race this year than be Director. The decision is one for the Club Committee but some debate at the AGM would be worthwhile.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

due 1 April 2000

Annual fees have been reviewed by the Committee and the new amounts are shown on the attached membership form. Factors considered include:

- 1. An increase in Public Liability Insurance from \$5 million to \$10 million as required by some councils before approval is given for a run.
- Extra funding required for use of venues. The Club must now pay \$5/11 Herdsman for almost all venues used including McCallum, Kings Park and Bold As an example, the recent Clydesdale run cost \$60.
- Extra costs for name badges which are now approximately \$10.00 each.
- With the advent of the GST from 1 July 2000, some of the Club's costs will increase and some will decrease. The Club is below the \$100,000 registration figure.
- Capitation fees will not be increased by AAVAC from the current amount of \$7.00 per member.
- 6. There was no increase in WAVAC annual fees last year.
- No further International Year of the Older Persons funding for track and field.
- The aging of club members means a larger proportion being in the over 70 category.

Woodman's Point Run February 20, 2000



We had only 49 starters compared to 68 last year. The average number of starters over four years is 60 - below average compared to centrally located events.

We enjoyed a cool, windy start to the race. Gusty east winds buffeted runners going north on the first leg and played havoc with recording and equipment. Numerous jelly fish stifled thoughts of swimming.

Many derelict industrial buildings along the northern leg of the event had been demolished and the running route was in its best shape. Planned future residential and mariner development could enhance it in the future.

Bob Schickert easily won the 9 kilometre men's section in 36:55 from Brian Danby. Shirley Bell won the woman's 9 kilometre in 46:04. The 6.4 kilometre men's section was won by Ian Davies from Darry Dahlstrom. Allison Aldrich and Susan Brand won the women's short run.

Walking records were broken by 2 Bunbury members. Greg McDowell took just over one minute of the previous 6.4 kilometre walk record. Rosemary Holloway smashed the women's 6.4 kilometre walk time. The 9 kilometre men's walk was we by John Mison at 50:46 - less than one minute behind the event's record of 49:56 in 1998. Michelle Mison was also close to the previous best time for the 9 kilometre women's walk (64:28 compared to 63:44 in 1999 which was also her time).

The club's new system of arranging helpers worked particularly well. We appreciate the assistance of all including Sue Jones, Sue Danby, Jackie and Vic Beaumont, David Brown, Keith Atkinson, Ray Hall, Bev Thornton, Maureen Pomery and Francis Lipscombe.

Tips for Submitting Race Reports on Disk or email

Race reports nicely typed up on disk or sent by email are very much appreciated as they save me a lot of time and reduce the chance of typing errors. However, I do tend to run into trouble when trying to format the reports for the Vetrun so here are some suggestions to make it easier for me and you! Rule of thumb- keep it simple!

- 1. Set the tabs before you start typing the results (If you used Microsoft Word this is done under the Format menu. Go to Tabs... and then type in the tab stop position. Click set in between each tab stop position.) The problem with using the default tab setting (which is very small) is that you end up with more than one tab stop between columns and I have to remove all the extra ones.
- 2. Simple is best so try not to use indents, section breaks, page breaks or columns as I just have to remove them to fit the report into the publishing program I use.
