Dear Jeff

Because of transport difficulties, due to the weight and bulk of high jump apparatus, this cannot be included in events such as time trials and for some time I have looked at ways and means of coping with this problem. Following a number of failures I have now HOPEFULLY, believe that I have

made a lightwieght, easily transportable contraption, using PVC tubing and old broom handles, for use at a sandpit (Fosbury Floppers need safety bags).

The longest component is about 1.5m in length and the apperatus can be placed in the back seat of a car. The height of the uprights is 1.6m but can be lengthened by 30cm if required. The crossbar is in two conectable sections giving a length of 2.1m and this can easily be extended if required. The whole thing is easily and quickly put together and includes a height measurement tape.

I now need a trial period and if anyone interested in High Jumping cares to give me a ring on 457 4557, she or he can give the contraption a try out and perhaps come up with some ideas for improvements. Meanwhile I shall inquire whether the Little Athletics Assc. could be interested in the light-weight crossbar, for safety reasons with children.

No application for a patent on this idea is envisaged and any old fool, armed with an electric drill and about \$10, could make one - one such just did!

The name of one of athletics' greatest ultra runners, John Tarrant, lives on in his home town of Hereford with a race, organised in his memory by one of his old friends. Now in its fourth year, the John Tarrant Memorial 50-mile road race on July 17 takes in five laps of a 10-mile course around the city, and the field will inevitably include some of the country's top distance runners.

Tarrant died in 1975 at the age of 46 after losing his battle against cancer. His running career had been both spectacular and controversial, and acts as a reminder of the way things used to be before the advent of more liberal attitudes towards athletics, amateurism and money.

A multi-world record holder at 40 miles and 100 miles, and the first runner to achieve the grand slam of winning Britain's four ultra-distance

classics in 1967, Tarrant was banned from international athletics when it was ruled that he had surrendered his amateur status by earning money at professional boxing tournaments as a youth.

He was initially banned from major races in Britain after revealing that he had won £17 in prize money at a boxing booth. Tarrant forced the Amateur Athletic Association to reassess his case by competing in races as an unofficial entrant and winning them. He was reinstated as an amateur but never allowed to represent his country.

His career wins include the London to Brighton race twice, and the Exeter to Plymouth event five times. He also won the Liverpool to Blackpool event, the Isle of Wight Marathon and the Isle of Man 40-mile road race three times each. In addition he finished fourth in the Comrades Marathon in South Africa

'n memoriam: John Tarrant takes a drink from his son

and won another 51 road races in the country during the two years it took him to save up for his return fare to Hereford.

He was diagnosed as having cancer in 1973 and went into hospital to have his stomach removed. Yet within six months he was back on his feet and taking part in a 10-mile run to raise money for the local hospital. It took him 75 minutes and he called it "the hardest run of my life". He died just over a year later.

The city already has a street named after its most famous athlete and the race is organiser Mick Wildig's own tribute to the man he first met in 1958.

He said: "John gave his all in every race, never shirked meeting

the best runners and never failed to admire and encourage the back markers. He used to say, 'Mick, if we are tired, just think how the poor souls at the back must feel'."

There are medals and certificates for all finishers and a host of prizes to be won in the race which starts and finishes at the home of Hereford United in Edgar Street.

Last year's winner, local man Martin Daykin, finished 22 minutes ahead of a high-quality field – including world record holder James Zarei – in 5:20. Further information and entry forms are available from the race organiser Mick Wildig at 31 Merryhill Crescent, Hunderton, Hereford HR2 7AH

A total of nine handicap races were conducted throughout the year and these were:-

Three of the runs were held in the worst weather of the year which made waiting to start uncomfortable, but the others were OK.

The system for calculating this year's handicap was changed so that every time for each race was converted to a time over an equivalent flat 10km course. The formula for calculating this takes into acount the distance raced and the degree of difficulty of the course. The handicap was calculated using the average of a runners three fastest equivalent 10km times in the 12 months preceding the race.

This system like most had its good and bad points. The equivalent 10km results were an excellent indication of comparitive times over different courses and distances.

Using the three fastest times however resulted in handicaps being corrected too slowly if handicap races were held close together. This part will be modified for current season

A total of 141 runers participated in at least one event, and a complete listing is attached. Top of the list with 147 points was Rob Davis. Rob ran in 7 of the 9 events winning one and coming second in another.

There wil only be 8 handicap races in the coming year six of which are the same plus two additional short runs. The longest run will be 11km. The first run will be the Kings Park X Country (13/5/90)


