## NOTICE OF EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

### Re Change of Club Name to MASTERS ATHLETICS WA Inc

**Date:** SUNDAY, 1 June 2003  
**Time:** 9.40 am at conclusion of club run/walk  
**Place:** Deepwater Point, The Esplanade, Mount Pleasant

### Purpose

Following acceptance by members present at the Annual General Meeting on 28 April 2003, of the motion to change the club name (50 votes for, 6 against), the Department of Consumer and Employment Protection was contacted to register the change. This extraordinary meeting has been called as that Department requires the club to upgrade its Constitution as part of the name change.

Notices of motion for this extraordinary general meeting are as follows:

#### 1. Change clause 37 of the Constitution to read:

This shall be the only Constitution of Masters Athletics WA Inc and shall come into force forthwith and shall not be altered, varied, added to or repealed unless 75% of financial members present at an Annual General Meeting or at a meeting specially convened for that purpose are in favour of such alteration, variation, addition or repeal.

(Clause 37 currently requires a two-thirds majority)

#### 2. Change clause 40(a) to read:

The Club may at any time with a consent of a majority of 75% of the members present at a General Meeting called for the purpose, be dissolved.

(Clause 40(a) currently requires a two-thirds majority)

#### 3. Change clause 40(b) to read:

If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Club there remains after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same must not be paid to or distributed among the members, or former members. The surplus property must be given or transferred to another association incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Act (1987) which has similar objects and which is not carried out for the purposes of profit or gain to its individual members, and which association shall be determined by resolution of the members.

(Clause 40(b) currently does not mention that the association to which the funds would be transferred would need to be incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Act (1987))

The Department of Consumer and Employment Protection has advised that there are advantages for tax purposes not to include the option of transfer of funds or surplus property to a charitable organisation as is included in the current clause 40(b).

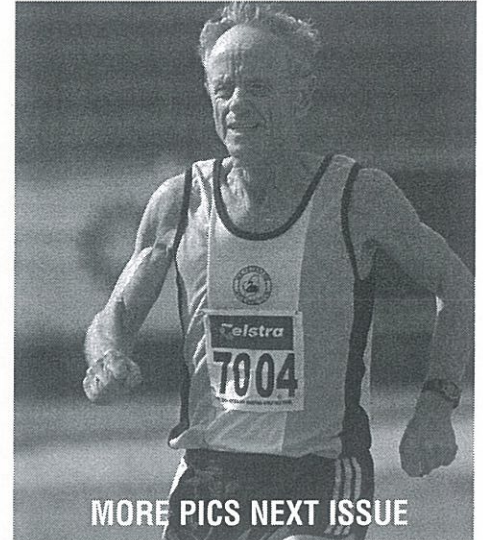

## LIFE MEMBER

One nomination for Life Membership was received, being that for Lynne Schickert. Proposed by Dorothy and Jeff Whittam and Jackie Halberg and approved by committee. Nomination accepted by all present and confirmed.

## NOTICES OF MOTION

Two notices of motion to amend the Constitution were received.

**Motion 1:** That clause 34(b) Honorary Membership be deleted.

This amendment was approved at the 2001 Annual General Meeting but not correctly registered with the Department of Consumer and Employment Protection. The amendment needs to be processed again by WAVAC if it is to take effect.

Moved Bob Schickert, seconded Cecil Walkley. Motion carried unanimously

**Motion 2:** That the name of the club be changed to Masters Athletics WA. Clause (1) to be amended by deletion of the words WA Veterans Athletic Club (Inc) and inserting Masters Athletics WA (Inc).

Moved by Bob Schickert, seconded by Kris Adrian. Motion carried: 50 votes for, 6 votes against, no abstainees. The two-thirds majority required was therefore achieved.

It was noted that the change of name would not come into effect until it has been officially registered.

## GENERAL BUSINESS

- Cecil Walkley asked if the club could provide a special award for "marvellous achievers" who recover from serious illness. He mentioned that club members generally recover much faster than the average recovery time. Passed to committee for consideration.

- Warren Davey presented a sprint grading system for the summer track season which he would be prepared to organise. Suggested by Lynne Schickert that this be used in post-Christmas part of T & F season to avoid clash with Patron's trophy competition. Committee to consider.

- Rob Shand expressed concern that the club only had one suitable 500gram javelin as the championships. Committee to investigate need to purchase another.

- Jeff Whittam proposed a vote of thanks to outgoing committee. Seconded Nick Miletic. Suitably acknowledged by all attendees.

- Mark Rosen expressed concern regarding inadequate drink stations on Sunday runs and scarcity of course marking. He suggested members be asked to nominate three help dates instead of two. Lynne Schickert will take this to the committee for consideration.

- Barrie Thomsett suggested a "volunteer" T-shirt be provided for regular helpers.

- Elaine Dance proposed that March Sunday events start at 7.00 am rather than 7.30am. Seconded by Nick Miletic. Elaine Dance then proposed that April Sunday event start at 7.30am rather than 8.00am. Seconded by Keith Atkinson. After some discussion this proposal was carried with the proviso that both changes to be effective from 2004/2005 program, ie runs scheduled in March and April 2005.

- Bob Schickert raised the matter of chest numbers being provided to assist in recording at Sunday runs. This matter had been raised previously at a committee meeting and feedback from the members was sought. Mixed views were expressed and no vote was taken. This issue will be considered further by new committee.

## MEETING CLOSED

As there was no more business, the President thanked the members for their contribution and closed the meeting at 8.53 pm.
