HOW many times did Kath Holland break the W35 60 metres record? WHO holds both the 100 mile, and 24 hour record for W45?

DID you know that Art Briffa set the first WAVAC 10K Road Run record in 1976 - at 39:02; and that Rob Shand, Maurice Smith, George Innes and Frank Smith progressively reduced this to 33:20 by 1989?

HOWEVER, none of them were faster than the man who set the current M50 record, at 32:50, in 1971! Yes, John Gilmour.

Fascinating facts for Vets, I'm sure you'll agree, which are now available to all members due to the outstanding work of Bob Sammells.

In a record-breaking effort of his own, Bob has assembled a progressive list of all WAVAC records - from 60 metres to six days, covering all road, track and field, and marathon events. He has scanned very copy of the Vetrun, from #1 to 237, and the result is a 63-page file.

It's unlikely that any other athletics club in Australia holds such a comprehensive archive of its members performances, and Bob is to be thanked for devoting so much time and diligent effort to the work.

However, please let Bob know if he has missed any records that can make

the document more thorough.

Many members will want a copy of this document, which makes fascinating reading even if, like me, you'll never find your own name in the lists! The club will make hard copies available to any member - simply contact secretary Brian Foley (339-2716). Alternatively, Bob will place the information on computer disc for you, provided you supply him with a formatted 3.5 inch diskette.

Also available, in hard or disc form, is a 14-page list of all current WA, Australian and World vets records.

Bob will be up-dating all of these record continually, and expects to print a new list annually.

...WHO set the M40 half-marathon record in 1980, knocked a second off in 1984, .13 seconds in 1985, and still holds it, together with the M50 record?

What's Stuart Hicks' M65 half-marathon record, set in 1990? What was Brian Paxman's record M45 800m time, in 1977?

Maybe I'll tell you next month. In the meantime, the library will hold a full set of these records.
