Athlete of the Mee

The championships have not been a one-woman show, despite the two world records for Lyn Ventris. In fact the Athlete of the Meet award was awarded quite deservedly to Lorraine Lopes. This trophy goes to the best age-graded performance during the championships. Lorraine scored over 98% in three different events.

At Cannington on March 15, her Australian record 10,000m run amassed 98.18% in reducing her own best time by almost two minutes. Lorraine followed this in the first event last Saturday with another AR in the 1500m (98.59%). The best was still to come. Although not an Australian record this time, another PB of 23m 30s over 5000m on Sunday morning edged the percentage up to 98.93%.

Lorraine has raised herself to the top level of Australian athletics with great performances of a very high calibre.


A very successful championships came to a close around 1pm Sunday. A provisional count of results show two world records, weekend. seven Australian and 17 state than records.





Lyn Ventris does not do things one at a time. In the Australian Masters Games last October she set two official world records and a 'world best'. So after breaking the W55 5000m track walk record again two days before the championship weekend another special performance was on the cards at WA Athletics Stadium.

This time it was the 3000m walk, officially only a 'world best' as this is not an IAAF championships event. Once more it was clear from the gun that Lyn was totally focussed on the clock. She left the whole field in her wake, sweeping home in 14m 16.41s to take a further ten seconds off her Adelaide time.


