Anzac Honour for Dave Scott

ONE of our club's finest distance runners, Dave Scott (no 102) has won a rare honour, as described below in the West Australian this week. At this year's Welcome Run he made a very welcome return to Masters running after a long absence with injury.

BUGLER'S TOP NOTE

Retired Army Lance-Corporal David Scott has played the Last Post on his bugle at Anzac Day services from Kings Park to Gallipoli, and this week he'll become one of only five people in the country to receive the Anzac of the Year award.



The award recognises outstanding contribution to the RSL, the wider veteran community and to the general public, and Scott's service certainly qualifies.

He served in the Army Reserve in the Army Band Perth for four decades, and, for the past 13 years as a sub warden of the State War Memorial, has attended an average of 35 services a year.

Throw in his bugling at veteran funerals, nursing homes, schools and AFL Anzac Day games and we doubt you'd find a WA bugler who'd played the Last Post more often.
