THE BIBBULMUN WALK '89.

The Bibbulmun Walk '89, organised by The Dpt of Conservation and Land Management to commemorate The 10th anniversary of the original Bibbulmun Walk, commenced on September 16th and, during the next 30 days, covered 625kms through The State Forests between Kalamunda and Walpole.

A "core" of 35 walkers traversed the whole distance; this number increased or decreased as "part-time" walkers joined or left us.

Incidently, ages ranged from 32 years to 72 years with an average age of 58 years and a ratio of 19 women to 16 men, among which number was Mary Robinson and myself proudly wearing our club's name tags.

A hike, covering such a distance and time, creates more incidents and situations than I can relate in this article so I needs must confine my anecdotes to only a few, such as:-

The war-time scene in Pickering Brook Community Hall at the end of the second day during which we had walked 30Kms. There, 'neath the bright fluorescent lights, were laid rows of sleeping-bags whereon reclined moaning bodies in various stages of dress as they attended to blistered and bruised feet or limbs. Real courage was shown at this juncture as some of the injuries were severe: like the over-weight chap whose legs rubbed together as he walked and wore away the skin off the inner thigh of both legs to show raw flesh. His determination to continue, despite the suffering, caused some anxiety until someone had a brilliant idea. He was transported back to Armadale where he purchased 2 pairs of cycling pants thereby eliminating the problem of friction. "Only got the holes in my feet to worry about now," he joyfully announced.

The rain which commenced next morning and continued for days and days.

The gypsy-camp appearence at Dwellingup where, under the gazebo on our first rest day, wet garments of various sizes, shapes, colours and quality were hung on improvised lines strung around a central log fire and how, during this mundane but necessary process, people became acquainted.

The heart-warming evening Mary and I had in cold, rain-swept Collie when one of my old army mates invited us to his house for a roast dinner with baked potatoes, pumpkin and cauliflower at a table covered with a linen cloth upon which glistened silverware and crystal glasses of red wine. Then, afterwards, sitting in the lounge-room before a warm fire as the rain hammered on the roof. Comradeship stretching back over 50 years.

Progressing through forests closing overhead yet spreading wild-flowers in abundance over hectares all around.

The sun glistening on the water of Wellington Dam.

Our most picturesque day should have been the one climbing over the hills behind Lewana Camp near Balingup but we scrambled up a sloppy, muddy road, in pouring rain, to eventually gaze at more rain falling away below us into the valleys beyond while we held our wet gear close as protection against the icy wind.

The spectacle of Mary pitching her tent in a high wind with one eye on a bank of blue-black clouds building up like a dumper in the surf.

Oh yes! There were joy-filled moments, too!

Laying warm, in a sleeping-bag, at 5am listening to song-birds greeting the coming day bearing its unknown challenges and experiencing a sense of "one-ness" with The Earth.

Sitting around a massive camp-fire at night talking to my fellow hikers as we held out wet socks to dry and enjoying the atmosphere of companionship with others who were in the same situation as myself.

The freedom from telephones, cars, T.V. and radios coupled with a contented feeling of tiredness at the end of a hard day.

The happiness of accomplishment as we walked into Walpule where a reception had been organised to greet us.

What impressions stand prominent above the rest?

Two!

The obvious concern, appreciation and knowledgeable shills applied by the staff of The Dpt. of Conservation and Land Management towards our forests. These people know them; they understand them and they are dedicated to the preservation and welfare of that whole vast area.

The manner in which 35 individuals from all walks of Life, each with their own idiosyncrasies, gradually coalesced into a group with which it was a joy to associate, as it pursued its predetermined goal.

Track Etiquette

In the last month we have been running the 1989-90 track and field time trials. We are lucky to be allowed to run on the University of Western Australia's track at McGilvray, however we don't want to push our luck. At the same time that we are using their excellent track they have training squads also running on the 400 metre track and the outside 600 metre track. There is no question of overcrowding if we, the Vets, use some thought on our behaviour at the track. Track etiquette applies, of course, at all times and basically is the conventional set of rules by which, from experience, it has been found that the best system works for all. Now a few of the more common rules:

- * Always look both ways before crossing the track. Never warm up on the inside tracks, the grass at McGilvray gets worn and synthetic tracks are also worn by distance events. Time trials are often being run on the inside tracks and there is absolutely no reason why warm ups need to be done on the track at all.
- * Always run through the finish line and off the track at the end of a race, if you stop and collapse you may be run in to by a fast finishing competitor behind, perhaps causing a nasty damage.
- * If you've been lapped in a race and, perhaps are not taking the race as seriously as you should, it is well mannered to move out for the faster leaders as they pass you. One person who stands out in doing this is Basil Worner, as usual the gentleman.
- * Don't run or walk two abreast in a race unless you are actually overtaking. Running wide means you are travelling further and it is very frustrating to have to move round two lanes.

If we stick to these few common sense rules we can exist happily with other athletes and our own meetings will be run more efficiently.



At the start Joe Record set out at a fast pace considering the high humidity, at the top of Armadale Hill, Joe was a clear leader with Ross Parker next looking very comfortable, with John Lewis, George Audley, Brian Kennedy and Garry Clark following.

Joe Record was the first to have problems and dropped out on the first day, George also had problems having an upset stonach for some 27 hours before retiring just before Arthur River, where Brian Kennedy also retired with

extreme hip problems.

This left Ross and John running within a few miles of each other to Mount Barker and Garry Clark running his own pace determined to finish. At Mount Barker John took less rest than expected and passed Ross, going on to win comfortably, Ross still looked very comfortable, Garry came in a distant 3rd, but everyone in the Ultra scene was as happy as he to see him finish in a very creditable time.

In my opinion, this years race was a much tougher race than last year. The first day was very humid and the second day very cold, wet and windy.
