# Notes from a meeting of State delegates - 6-12-86

Attended by W.A. President, Leo Hassam

Statistics and records are now being kept by the National Statistician.

Hammer and Triple Jump (women) confirmed as World Championship events.

Uniforms - Australian uniforms will be available for Easter Championships. Only members of Vets Clubs will be able to purchase these to wear in Melbourne at the World Championships.

Reports on membership were given by all states except Victoria. These reports to be forward to Mike Hall for an article in the Veteran Athlete. The general trends indicate membership is rising rapidly in most states, particularly where the recreational and social aspects are emphasised.

AAVAC Finances - Consideration needs to be given about future finance for the AAVAC. Alternatives can be:

a) Increase of per capita levy of state membershipb) Levy on competitors at National Championships

c) Percentage of Sponsorship raised by the AAVAC to service the AAVAC instead

of all going to state hosting the Nationals.

d) Accommodation for Championships arranged through AAVAC with agents booking fees going to AAVAC.

All affiliation fees to WAVA, AAU and CAS are going to be increased in the next financial year. We now have a viable national newspaper, at present the World Veterans Games OB is able to subsidise it and also secretarial expenses, but after 1987 this option will not be possible.

Report was given about preparations for World Games in Melbourne. More than 2000 persons from overseas have now booked accommodation and paid deposits.

A new medal design for the national championships is being looked at by NSW. It has been recommended that one side will remain constant with the reverse side changing for each state if the cost factor is not too high to the host state.

Recommendation from QLD that 50-59 men should use a 700grm javelin. This is an internationally recognised javelin used by juniors and easily available. Delegates are to ask athletes about this change and if the majority agree at the Nationals in 1987, a motion will be put to WAVA for the Congress in 1987.

#### MEMBERSHIP REPORTS

NSW - New South Wales Membership as at 3rd December, 1986 was 550 with 103 unfinancial. They are gaining at a rate of 15 per month.

ACTVAC - Membership at 1st December, 1986 was 313. By far the biggest majority are males in the M40-M45 age groups.

SAVAC - Men 100 Men 35 2, M40 20, M45 23, M50 17, M55 18, M60 13, M65 2, M70 4, M75 1 Pre-vets 2, Req. with AASA 34, Club Members 64.

Women 27  $\overline{\text{W30 2}}$ ,  $\overline{\text{W35 4}}$ ,  $\overline{\text{W40 11}}$ ,  $\overline{\text{W45 6}}$ ,  $\overline{\text{W50 2}}$ ,  $\overline{\text{W55 2}}$ . Prevets 2, Reg with AASA 16, Club Members 9.

TASMANIA - Current membership 30 women, 135 men.

- QLD Membership at 6th December, 1986
  380 members at the moment, comprising 300 men and 80 women.
  Signed on approx. 90 new members since 1.4.86, but have lost about 60 members who are unfinancial.
- W.A. The present membership (as at 19.11.86.) of the WAVAC stands at 342. There are 102 women and 240 men.
